

Shooting of a certain game is allowed only with the appropriate ammunitions:

- Bear with the rifled rifle of 7 mm calibre or more, and the bullet weight of 170 grains or more.
- Chamois with the rifled rifle of 5.1 mm calibre or more (.222), and the bullet weight of 93 grains and more.
- Roe deer with the grooved rifle of 4.1 mm calibre and more, and the bullet weight of 90 grains or more.
- Wild boar with the grooved rifle of 7 mm calibre or more, and the bullet weight of 160 grains or more and with the shotgun using Brenneke or Ideal pellet.
- Mouflon sheep with the grooved rifle of 6 mm calibre or more, and the bullet weight of 130 grains.
- Capercaillie with the grooved rifle of 4.1 mm calibre or more, and the bullet weight of 45 grains or more, and with the shotgun with the pellet of 4 mm or more.
- Partridge (UK size 7), pheasant (UK size 5 and 6), mallard, hare and goose (UK size 4) - pellet of 3 mm or more.
- Woodcock, quail, turtle-dove with the shotgun using the pellet of 2.5 mm or more (UK size 7.5 and 8).
